After BlueView successfully completed extensive acceptance trials, Australian Customs executed an order for BlueView's P900 multibeam sonar to be integrated on to their fleet of Ocean Modules Pty Ltd. V8 Sii Remotely Operated Vehicles.

Australian Customs is that nation's primary border protection agency. Customs has been investing heavily in new technology to boost protection against potential seaborne threats at Australian seaports. Starting immediately, BlueView's P900 will be performing hull and berth inspections ensuring that any contraband attached to vessels' hulls is identified and intercepted.
